At age 15, it is common for Filipinos in the countryside to give up formal education and find low-paying jobs to support their family. While the abandonment of one's education to support the family seems heroic, it is a actually a result of a choice between survival and a chance to be in the classroom. It is a vicious cycle that eventually drives a family to lower degrees of poverty and even crime in some occasions. The loss of access to education limits the potential of young children who can be great in their own ways.

- US\$ 100 can send a child to elementary school for a year and help him or her understand the alphabet and numbers, write his or her name and thoughts, learn about science, appreciate history and do basic math.
- US\$ 140 can send a student to high school for a year and help prepare them for responsible adulthood and wage-level employment.
 - US\$ 635 to 825 can fund a 10 to 15-month full vocational course.
- US\$ 300 to 600, a semester or a year in college; and help provide young adults
 with professional expertise and prepare them for leadership and higher level of
 employment.
 - Donors can also donate books, computers, science laboratory supplies and equipment, and other educational aids.
