



## **HEALTH AND WELFARE**

Around the Philippines, many communities remain to be economically underserved and with limited access to health care programs and doctors, as well as welfare programs.

> In a country frequently hit by tropical storms, floods, landslides, and occasional earthquakes and volcanic eruptions, families get dislocated and members' health are put at risk.

Help provide the health needs of underserved communities, assist in the rehabilitation of calamity-stricken villages, and lend a hand in rebuilding the lives of calamity survivors.

- US\$ 1,400 can support a feeding program. The amount covers the cost of the supplemental feeding of 30 children for six months, which is designed to provide malnourished children, seven years old and below, with complete and nutritionally-balanced meals.
- US\$ 1 or more can fund the basic needs and support calamity relief assistance to affected beneficiaries in times of calamities or sponsor a particular rehabilitation projects.
- Donors may also conduct medical/surgical/dental missions to provide free health services and medicines to indigent patients, or donate medical supplies and equipment to public hospitals and health centers.
